Materials List for this Class:

- Graphite Pencil Set of 12 (6B,5B,4B,3B,2B,B,HB,F,H,2H,3H,4H) (minimum: 4B,2B,HB,2H) {I prefer STAEDTLER'S graphite pencil "Design Drafting" set.} Blick has a similar set of 12. Both brands are available in open stock.
- 9" x 12" pad of Bristol Smooth paper (Strathmore [300 Series; yellow cover], Blick, or Canson. {Canson also makes Canson XL recycled paper that is 2-sided--smooth on the front and vellum on the back.})
- Pencil sharpener - handheld or electric (corded or battery powered). [Spiral cutter sharpeners are better than single blade sharpeners.]
- White Vinyl Eraser
- Kneaded Eraser (medium or large size)
- Tombow Mono Zero Eraser (round) (small white eraser for detail areas).
- Click-type eraser (white plastic eraser in its own pencil-like holder).
- Straight edge or see-through ruler (12" or longer).
- Paper stumps for blending (assorted sizes).
- Sanding block (1" x 4" sandpaper stapled to a wood paddle).
- Soft bristle brush (to brush off eraser debris and pigment crumbs).
- Copy paper (to place under hand while drawing).
